The word Catholike, though in the title of this Epiftle & the reft following (called, the Catholike Epiftles) it be not wholy in the fame fenfe as it is in the Creed, yet the Protestants so feare and abhorre the word altogether, that in some of their Bibles they leaue it cleane out, although it be in the Greek, and in some they had rather translate ridiculously thus, The General Epistle, &c. whereas these are famously known and specified in antiquitie by the name of Catholike Epistles, for that they are written to the whole Church, not to any pecu-

liar people or perfon, as S. Paules are.

The Protestats abhorre the word Catholike.
