The word Catholike, though in the title of this Epiftle & the reft following (called, the Catholike Epiftles) it be not wholly in the fame fenfe as it is in the Creed, yet the Proteftants fo feare and abhorre the word altogether, that in fome of their Bibles they leaue it cleane out, although it be in the Greek, and in fome they had rather tranflate ridiculoufly thus, *The General Epiftle*, &c. whereas thefe are famoufly known and fpecified in antiquitie by the name of Catholike Epiftles, for that they are written to the whole Church, not to any peculiar people or perfon, as S. Paules are.

The Proteftants abhorre the word *Catholike*.
