He commendeth Gaius, for continuing in the truth, & for fufteining or fuccouring true Preachers, 9. noting Diotrepes for the contrarie, and praifing Demetrius.

he Seniour to Gaius the Deareft, whom I loue in truth.

My Deereft, concerning al things I make my praier that thou proceed profperoufly, and fare wel, as thy foule doth profperoufly. <sup>3</sup> I was exceeding glad when the Brethren came, and gaue teftimonie to thy truth, euen as thou walkeft in truth. <sup>4</sup> Greater 'thãke' haue I not of thẽ, that then I may heare my childrẽ doe walke in truth. <sup>5</sup> My Deareft, thou doeft faithfully whatfoeuer thou workeft on the Brethren, <sup>a</sup>)& that vpon ftrangers. <sup>6</sup> They haue rendred teftimonie to thy charitie in the fight of the Church: whom, thou fhalt doe wel, bringing on their way in manner worthie of God. <sup>7</sup> For, for his name did they depart, taking nothing of the Gentils. <sup>8</sup> We therfore ought to receiue fuch: that we may be coadiutours of the truth.
