Chapter 9

Other nations fearing Ifrael ioyne their forces to fight againft them, 3. but the Gabaonites fend embaffadors, feyning craftily to come farre of, 14. with whom Iofue and the ancientes of Ifrael make league binding it by oath. 16. Within three dayes they are detected to be nere inhabitantes. VVherupon the people murmur againft their princes. VVho yet for their oath, let the Gabaonites liue, 20. only making them and their progenie perpetual feruantes, to cutte wood, and carie water.

Vhich thinges being heard, al the kinges beyond Iordan, that dwelt by the fea fide and the fhore of the great fea, they also that dwelt befide Libanus, the Hetheite and Amorreite, the Chananeite, the Pherezeite, and the Heueite, and the Iebufeite, ² were gathered, to fight against Iosue and Israel with one minde, and one fentence. ³ But they that dwelt in Gabaon, hearing al thinges that Iofue had done to Iericho and Hai: 4 fubtelly deuifing tooke prouifion for them felues. laying old fackes vpon their affes, and bottels of wine rent and fowed againe, 5 and fhoes very old which for a flow of oldenesse were clouted with speckes, putting on them old garmentes: the loaues also, which they caried for prouifion by the way, were heard, and broken into peeces: 6 and they went on to Iofue, who then abode in the campe at Galgal, and faid to him, and withal to al Ifrael: We are come from a farre countrie, defirous to make peace with you. And the children of Ifrael answered them, and faid: 7 Left perhaps you dwel in the Land which is dew to vs by lotte, and we can not enter a league with you. 8 But they faid to Iofue: We are thy feruantes. To whom Iofue faid: Who are you? and whence came you? ⁹ They answered: From a very farre countrie are thy feruantes come in the name of the Lord thy God. For we have heard the fame of his might, al thinges that he did in Ægypt, ¹⁰ and to the two kinges of the Amorrheites that were beyond Iordan, Sehon the king of Hefebon, and Og the king of Bafan, that were in

Aftaroth: 11 and our ancientes, and al the inhabitantes of our Land faid to vs: Take in your handes victuals for a very long way, and goe meete them, and fay: We are your feruantes, enter a league with vs. 12 Behold, these loaues we tooke hotte, when we departed from our houses to come to you, now they are become drie, and broken for ouer much oldeneffe. 13 The bottels of wine we filled being new, now they are burft & diffolued. The garmentes and fhoes that we have vpon vs, and which we have on our feete, for the length of the long way are worne, and almost confumed. 14 They tooke therfore of their victuals, and a) asked not the mouth of our Lord. ¹⁵ And Iofue made peace with them, and entring a league promifed that they flould not be flaine: the princes also of the multitude fware to them. ¹⁶ But three daies after that the league was made, they heard that they dwelt nigh, and they fhould be among them. ¹⁷ And the children of Ifrael removed the campe, and came into their cities the third day, whose names are these, Gabaon, and Chaphira, and Beroth, and Chariathiarim. 18 And they ftroke them not, because the princes of the multitude had fworne in the name of our Lord the God of Ifrael. Therfore all the common people murmured against the princes. ¹⁹ Who answered them: We have fwome to them in the name of our Lord the God of Ifrael, and therfore we may not touch them. ²⁰ But this we wil doe to them: Let them be referred in dede aliue, left the wrath of God be ftirred against vs, if we shal be forfworne: 21 but fo let them liue, that for the vses of the whole multitude they hew wood, and carie in water. Who fpeaking these thinges, ²² Iosue called the Gabaonites, and faid to them: Why would you deceive vs by fraude to fay: We dwel very farre of from you, wheras you are

^a In fuch a case they ought to have consulted God, to witte, the high Priest, putting on the Ephod & Rationale, should have prayed at the dore of the tabernacle, where our Lord appointed to speake vnto him. Exo. 19. v. 42. It was also ordained Num. 17. v. 21. that Eleazar should cosult our Lord, when anie thing was to be donne by Iosue, which omittig to do they were deceived by these Gabaonites.

in the middes of vs? 23 Therfore you shal be vnder a curfe, and they shal not faile of your stocke a hewer of wood, and a carier of water into the house of my God. ²⁴ Who answered: It was told vs thy feruantes, that the Lord thy God had promifed Moyfes his feruant, that he would deliuer you al the Land, and would deftroy al the inhabitantes thereof. Therefore we feared exceedingly and prouided for our liues, copelled by your terrour, and we tooke this counfel. ²⁵ And now we are in thy hand: that which feemeth vnto thee good and right, doe to vs. ²⁶ Iofue therfore did as he had faid, and deliuered them from the hand of the children of Ifrael, that they should not be flaine. 27 And he decreed in that day, that a)they should be in the ministerie of all the people, and of the altar of our Lord, hewing wood, and carving water, vntil this prefent time, in the place which our Lord hath chofen.
