## Chapter 22

The tribes of Ruben and Gad, and half Manafses returne to their poffefsions. 10. VVho building an altar by the fide of Iordan, the other tribes fulpect that they wil make a fchifme, and therfore purpole to fight againft them. 13. But firft fending an ambaffage to admonish them, 21. they answer that they made not an altar, for facrifice, but only for a monument, that notwithftading they dwel on the other fide of Iordan, yet they are of the fame people of God, 30. wherwith al Ifrael is fatisfied.

The fourth part. Two tribes & a halfe returne to their poffeffions; Iofues godly admonitions; & his, and Eleazars death.

he fame time Iofue called the Rubenites, and Gadites, and the halfe tribe of Manaffes, <sup>2</sup> and faid to them: You have done al thinges that Movfes the feruant of our Lord comanded you: me alfo haue you obeyed in al thinges, <sup>3</sup> neither haue you left your brethren a long time, vntil this prefent day, keeping the commandement of our Lord vour God. <sup>4</sup> Therfore becaufe our Lord your God hath geuen your brethren quietnes and peace, as he promifed: returne, and goe into your tabernacles, and to the land of your pofferfion, which Moyfes the feruant of our Lord delivered to you beyond Iordan: <sup>5</sup> a) alwayes fo that you keep attentiuely, and in worke fulfil the commandement, and the law which Moyfes the feruant of our Lord commanded you, that you loue our Lord your God, and walke in al his wayes, and obferue al his commandementes, & cleaue to him, and ferue him in al your hart, and in al your foule. <sup>6</sup> And Iofue <sup>b</sup>)bleffed them, and difmiffed them. Who returned into their tabernacles. <sup>7</sup> And to the halfe tribe of Manaffes Moyfes had geuen poffeffion in Bafan: and therfore to the halfe that remayned, Iofue gaue a lotte among the reft of their brethren beyond Iordan at the Weft fide. And when he difmiffed them into their tabernacles, & had bleffed them, <sup>8</sup> he faid to them:

In much fubftance and riches returne to your feates, with filuer and gold, braffe and yron, and varietie of rayment: diuide the praye of your enemies with your brethren. <sup>9</sup> And the children of Ruben, and the children of Gad, and the halfe tribe of Manaffes returned. and went from the children of Ifrael in Silo, which is fituated in Chanaan, to enter into Galaad the Land of their pofferition, which they had obtevned according to the commandement of our Lord in the hand of Moyfes. <sup>10</sup> And when they were come to the litle banckes of Iordan, into the Land of Chanaan, they built befide Iordan an altar of an infinite greatnes. <sup>11 a)</sup>Which thing when the children of Ifrael had heard, and certaine meffengers had reported to them that the children of Ruben, and Gad, and the halfe tribe of Manaffes had builded an altar in the Land of Chanaan, vpon the litle banckes of Iordan, against the children of Ifrael: <sup>12</sup> they affembled al in Silo, that they might goe vp, and fight againft them. <sup>13</sup> And in the meane time they fent to them into the Land of Galaad, Phinees the fonne of Eleazar the prieft, <sup>14</sup> and ten princes with him, one of euerie tribe.  $^{15}$  Who came to the children of Ruben, and Gad, and the halfe tribe of Manaffes into the Land of Galaad, and faid to them: <sup>16</sup> This meffage doth al the people of our Lord fend to you: What is this tranfgreffion? Why haue you forfaken our Lord the God of Ifrael, building a facrilegious altar, and reuolting from the worfhippe of him? <sup>17</sup> Is it a fmale thing to you that <sup>b</sup>)you finned in Beelphegor, and vntil this prefent day the fpotte of this abomination abideth in vs? and many of the people fel dead. <sup>18</sup> And you to day haue forfaken our Lord, and to morrow his wrath wil rage <sup>c)</sup>againft al Ifrael.

<sup>19</sup> But if you thinke the land of your poffertion to be vncleane, paffe to the Land, wherein is the tabernacle of our Lord, and dwel among vs: only that you depart not from our Lord, and from our companie, an altar being built befide the altar of our Lord God. <sup>20</sup> Did not Achan chap. 7. the fonne of Zare tranfgrefs the commandement of our Lord, and his wrath lay vpon al the people of Ifrael? And he was one man, and I would he alone had perifhed in his wicked fact. <sup>21</sup> And the children of Ruben, and Gad, and of the halfe tribe of Manaffes answered the princes of the legacie of Ifrael: <sup>22</sup> The moft mightie God our Lord, The moft mightie God our Lord, him felfe knoweth, and Ifrael together shal vnderftand: If with the mind of preuarication we have erected this altar, let him not keepe vs, but punifh vs prefently: <sup>23</sup> and if we did it with that minde, that we might lay vpon it holocauftes, and facrifice, and pacifique victimes, let him felfe examine it and iudge: <sup>24</sup> and not rather with that meaning and deliberation, that we faid: To morrow your children wil fay to our children: What haue you to doe with our Lord the God of Ifrael? <sup>25</sup> Our Lord hath put a border betwen vs and you, O ye children of Ruben, and children of Gad, the river Iordan: and therfore you have no part in our Lord. And by this occasion your children fhal auert our children from the feare of our Lord. We therfore thought it better, <sup>26</sup> and faid: Let vs build vs an altar, <sup>a</sup>)not for holocauftes, nor to offer victimes, <sup>27</sup> but for a teftimonie betwen vs and you, and our iffue and your progenie, that we may ferue our Lord, and it may be our right to offer both holocauftes, and victimes, and pacifique hoftes: and that your children to morrow fay not to our children: You have no part in our Lord. <sup>28</sup> And if they wil fay fo, they fhal anfwer them: Behold the altar of our Lord, which our

fathers made, not for holocauftes, nor for Sacrifice, but for our teftimonie and yours. <sup>29</sup> God faue vs from this abomination that we should reuolt from our Lord, and leave his fteppes, erecting an altar to offer holocauftes, and facrifices, and victimes, befide the altar of our Lord God, which is erected before his tabernacle. <sup>30</sup> Which thinges being heard, Phinees the prieft, and the princes of the legacie, which were with him, were pacified: and they admitted moft willingly the wordes of the children of Ruben, & Gad, and of the halfe tribe of Manaffes. <sup>31</sup> And Phinees the prieft the fonne of Eleazar faid to them: Now we know that our Lord is with vs, becaufe you are not culpable of this preuarication, and have deliuered the children of Ifrael from the hand of our Lord. <sup>32</sup> And her returned with the princes from the children of Ruben and Gad, out of the Land of Galaad, into the Land of Chanaan, to the children of Ifrael, and reported to them. <sup>33</sup> And the faying pleafed al that heard it. And the children of Ifrael prayfed God, and they did no more fay, that they would goe vp againft them, and fight, and deftroy the Land of their pofferfion. <sup>34</sup> And the children of Ruben, & the children of Gad called the altar, which they had built, Our teftimonie, that our Lord he is God.
