Chapter 23

Iofue being old admonisheth the people to keepe Gods commandementes, 12. and to auoide mariages, and al focietie with gentiles, left falling to idolatrie God as certainly punish them, as he hath benne benificial, and bountiful to them.

nd when much time was paffed, after that our Lord had geuen peace to Ifrael, al the nations being fubdewed round about, and Iofue now verie ancient, and of a great age: ² Iofue called al Ifrael, and the elders, and the princes and the judges, and the maifters, and faid to them: I am old, and farre gone in age: 3 and you fee al thinges, that our Lord your God hath done to all the nations round about, a)how him felfe hath fought for you: 4 and now because he hath by lotte divided to you al the Land, from the East part of Iordan vnto the great fea, and manie nations yet remaine: 5 Our Lord your God wil deftroy them, and take them away from your face, and you shal poffeffe the Land, as he hath promifed you. 6 Onlie take courage, and be careful, that you keepe al thinges which be written in the volume of the law of Moyfes: and decline not from them neither to the right hand nor to the left: 7 left after that you are entred in to the Gentiles, which fhal be among you, you fweare in the name of their goddes, and ferue them, and adore them: 8 but cleaue to our Lord your God: which you have done vntil this day. 9 And then our Lord God wil take away in your fight the great nations and very ftrong, and no man shal be able to refift you.

a God fought for the Ifraelites three maner of wayes: fometimes alone, they not fighting at al, as when the Ægyptians were drowned in the read fea: fometimes they doing his comandmentes he apparently affifted them, as in the fiege of Iericho, the walles miraculoufly fel downe (c. 6.) & haile ftones killed their enimies (chap. 10.) but most times inuifibly, as wel by geuing them courege, as by ftriking their enimies with terrour. And all these wayes God also fighteth for his feruantes in spiritual warres against the diuel, the flesh, & the world.

¹⁰ One of you fhal purfew a thoufand men of the enemies: becaufe our Lord your God him felf wil fight for you, as he hath promifed. 11 This onlie beware very diligently before hand, that you loue our Lord your God. 12 But if you wil cleaue to the errour of these nations, that dwel among you, and make mariages with them, and ioyne amitie: ¹³ euen now know ye that our Lord your God wil not deftroy them before your face, but they fhal be a pitte and a fnare for you, and a ftumbling blocke at your fide, and ftakes in your eies, til he take you away and deftroy you from this excellent Land, which he hath deliuered to you. 14 Behold I this day enter into the way of al flesh, and you shal know with al your minde that all the wordes, which our Lord promifed that he would perform to you, one is not escaped without effect. 15 Therfore as he hath fulfilled in deede that which he promifed, and al thinges profperous have come: fo wil he bring vpon you what euils foeuer he hath threatened, til he take you away and deftroy you from this excellent Land, which he hath deliuered to you, 16 because you have transgressed the covenant of our Lord your God, which he hath made with you, and have ferued ftrange goddes, and adored them: quickly and in haft shal the furie of our Lord ryfe againft you, and you shal be taken away from this excellent Land, which he hath delivered to you.
