## Chapter 12

Ephraites rifing against Iephte, fourtie two thousand of them are flaine. 8. Abesan is Iudge. 11. After him Ahialon. 13. Then Abdon.

ut behold in Ephraim there arose a fedition. For they paffing against the North, faid to Iephte: Going to fight againft the children of Ammon, why wouldft thou not cal vs, that we might goe with thee? Therfore we wil burne thy house. <sup>2</sup> To whom he answered: I and my people were at great strife against the children of Ammon: and I called you, that you should avde me, and you would not doe it. <sup>3</sup> Which I feeing a)put my life in myne owne handes, and paffed to the children of Ammon, and our Lord deliuered them into my handes. What have I deferued, that you rife against me in battel. 4 Therfore al the men of Galaad being called to him, he fought against Ephraim: and the men of Galaad ftroke Ephraim, because he had faid: b)Galaad is a fugitive of Ephraim, and dwelleth in the middes of Ephraim and Manaffes. <sup>5</sup> And the Galaadites tooke the fordes of Iordan, by the which Ephraim was to returne. And when there had come to the fame one of the number of Ephraim, fleeing, and had faid: I befech you let me paffe: The Galaadites faid to him: Art thou not an Ephraite? Who faying: I am not: 6 they asked him: Say then Schibboleth, which is interpreted an Eare of corne. Who answered, Sibboleth, not being able by the fame letter to expresse, an eare of corne. And immediatly being apprehended they killed him in the very paffage of Iordan. And there fel at that time of Ephraim two and fourtie thousand. <sup>7</sup> Therfore Iephte the Galaadite judged Ifrael fix yeares: and he died, and was buried

in his citie of Galaad. <sup>8</sup> After him Abefan of Bethlehem iudged Ifrael: <sup>9</sup> who had thirtie fonnes, and as manie daughters, which he fending abrode, gaue to hufbandes, and tooke wives for his fonnes of the fame number, bringing them into his houfe. Who iudged Ifrael feuen yeares: <sup>10</sup> and died and was buried in Bethlehem. <sup>11</sup> To whom fucceeded Ahialon a Zabulonite: and he iudged Ifrael ten yeares: <sup>12</sup> and he died and was buried in Zabulon. <sup>13</sup> After him Abdon iudged Ifrael, the fonne of Illel a Pharathonite: <sup>14</sup> who had fourtie fonnes, and of them thirtie nephewes, mounting vpon feuentie affe coltes, and he iudged Ifrael eight yeares: <sup>15</sup> and he died, and was buried in Pharathon of the Land of Ephraim, in the mount of Amalec.
