Chapter 15

Certaine precepts concerning Sacrifices, 17. and firft fruites, are repeted, 22. alfo touching different punishment of finne comitted by ignorance and by fet wilfulnes: 32. and accordingly one is ftoned to death, for gathering flickes on the Sabbath day. 37. Al are commanded to carie a figne in their garments, therby to remember the commandments of God.

nd our Lord fpake to Moyfes, faying: ² Speake to the children of Ifrael, and thou fhalt fay to them: When you shal be entred into the Land of your habitation, which I wil geue you, ³ and shal make oblation to the Lord for an holocauft, or victime, paying vowes, or voluntarily offering giftes, or in your folemnities burning a fweete fauour vnto the Lord. of oxen or of sheepe: 4 whofoeuer immolateth the victime, shal offer a facrifice of flowre, the tenth part of an ephi tempered with oyle, which shal have in meafure the fourth part of an hin: ⁵ and wine of the fame meafure to powre the libamentes shal he geue for the holocauft or for the victime. For euerie lambe 6 and ramme there shal be a facrifice of flowre of two tenthes, which shal be tempered with oile the third part of an hin: 7 and wine for the libamente, the third part of the fame measure, shall he offer for a fweete fauour to the Lord. ⁸ But when thou makeft an holocauft or hofte of oxen, to fulfil thy vow or for pacifique victimes, ⁹ thou shalt geue for euerie oxe three tenthes of flowre tempered with oile, which shal haue halfe the meafure of an hin: ¹⁰ and wine to powre libamentes of the fame meafure for an oblation of moft fweete fauour to the Lord. ¹¹ So shalt thou doe ¹² for euerie oxe and ramme and lambe and buckegoate. ¹³ As wel they that are borne in the countrie as the ftrangers ¹⁴ after one rite shal offer facrifices. ¹⁵ There shal be al one precept and iudgement as wel to your felues as to the ftrangers of the land. ¹⁶ Our Lord fpake to Moyfes, faving: ¹⁷ Speake to the children of Ifrael, and thou shalt fay to them: ¹⁸ When you are come into the land, which

I wil geue you, ¹⁹ and shal eate of the breades of that countrie, you shal feparate first fruites to the Lord ²⁰ of your meates. As of your barne floores you feparate firft fruites, ²¹ fo of your paftes shal you geue first fruites to the Lord. ²² And if through ignorance you omitte any of thefe thinges, which the Lord hath fpoken to Moyfes, ²³ and by him hath commanded you, from the day that he beganne to command and fo forward, ²⁴ and the multitude haue forgotten to do it: they shal offer a calfe out of the heard, an holocaufte for a most five fauour to the Lord, and the facrifice and libamentes theref, as the ceremonies require, and a buckegoate for finne: ²⁵ and the prieft shal pray for al the multitude of the children of Ifrael: and it shal be forgeven them, becaufe they finned not wittingly, offering notwithftanding burnt facrifice to the Lord for them felues and for their finne and errour: 26 and it shal be forgeuen al the people of the children of Ifrael, and the ftrangers, that feiourne among them, becaufe it is the fault of all the people through ignorance. ²⁷ But if one foule shal finne vnwitting, he shal offer a she goate of a yeare old for his finne: ²⁸ and the prieft shal pray for him, becaufe he finned vnwitting before the Lord: and he shal obteine him pardon, and it shal be forgeuen him. ²⁹ As wel to them that are borne in the countrie as to the ftrangers one law shall be for al, that finne by ignorance. ³⁰ But the foule, that a)through pride committeth any thing, whether he be borne in the countrie, or a ftranger, (becaufe he hath bene rebellious against the Lord) shal perish out of his people: ³¹ for he hath contemned the word of the Lord, and made his precept of no effect: therfore shal he be deftroyed, and shal beare his iniquitie. ³² And it came to paffe, when the children of Ifrael were in the wilderneffe, and had found a man gathering flickes on the Sabbath day, ³³ they prefented him to Moyfes and Aaron and

the whole multitude. ³⁴ Who shut him into prifon, not knowing what they should doe with him. ³⁵ And our Lord faid to Moyfes: a)Dying let this man die, let al the multitude ftone him without the campe. ³⁶ And when they had brought him out, they ftoned him, and he died as our Lord had commanded. ³⁷ Our Lord alfo faid to Moyfes: ³⁸ Speake to the children of Ifrael, and thou shalt fay to them, that they make them felues ^b)fringes in the corners of their garmentes, putting in them ribandes of hyacinth: ³⁹ which when they shal fee, they may remêber al the commandements of the Lord, and not folow their owne cogitations and eies fornicating after diuers thinges, 40 but rather mindful of the preceptes of the Lord may do them, and be holie to their God. ⁴¹I the Lord your God, that brought you out of the Land of Ægypt, that I might be your God.
