n the first years of Cyrus king of the Persians, that the word of our Lord by the mouth of Ieremie might be accomplished, our Lord rayled vp the fpirit of Cyrus king of Perfians: and he made proclamation in al his kingdom, yea by wryting, faying: ² Thus favth Cyrus king of the Perfians: Al the kingdomes of the earth hath the Lord the God of heauen geuen me, & he hath commanded me that I fhould build him a house in Ierufalem, which is in Iewrie. ³ Who is there among you of al his people? His God be with him. Let him goe vp into Ierufalem, which is in Iewrie, and build the house of the Lord the God of Ifrael, he is the God that is in Ierufalem. ⁴ And let al the reft in al places wherfoeuer they dwel, let euery man of his place helpe him, with filuer and gold, and fubftance, and cattel, befides that which they offer voluntarily to the temple of God, which is in Ierufalem. ⁵ And there rose vp the princes of the fathers of Iuda and Beniamin, & the Prieftes, and Leuites, and euerie one, whose spirit God raysed vp, to goe vp to build the temple of our Lord, which was in Ierufalem. ⁶ And al that were round about, ^a)did helpe their handes in veffels of filter, and of gold, in fubstance, and beaftes, in furniture, befides those thinges which they had offered voluntarily. ⁷ King Cyrus also brought forth the veffels of the temple of our Lord, which Nabuchodonofor had taken of Ierufalem, and had put them in the temple of his god. 8 But Cyrus the king of Perfians brought them forth by the hand of Mithridates the fonne of Gazabar, & numbred them to Saffabafar the prince of Iuda. 9 And

this is the number of them; Phials of gold thirtie, phials of filuer a thoufand, kniues twentie nine, goblettes of gold thirtie, ¹⁰ goblettes of filuer of the fecond order, foure hundred tenne: other veffels a thoufand. ¹¹ Al the veffels of gold and filuer, fiue thoufand foure hundred: Saffabafar tooke al with them, that went vp from the tranfmigration of Babylon into Ierufalem.
