

## Chapter 2

*The names and number of ſpecial men, which returned vnder the conduct of Zorobabel into Ierufalem: 66. their ſubſtance of cattel, 68. and their oblations for the reedifying of the Temple.*

**A**nd <sup>a)</sup>theſe are the children of the prouince, that went vp from the captiuitie, which Nabuchodonofor the king of Babylon had tranſported into Babylon, and returned into Ierufalem and Iuda, euerie man into his citie. <sup>2</sup> They that came with Zorobabel, Iofue, Nehemia, Saraia, Rahelaia, Mardochai, Belfan, Meſphar, Beguai, Rehum, Baana. The number of the men of the people of Ifrael: <sup>3</sup> The children of Pharos, two thouſand an hundred ſeuentie two. <sup>4</sup> The children of Sephatia, three hundred ſeuentie two. <sup>5</sup> The children of Area, ſeuen hundred ſeuentie five. <sup>6</sup> The children of Phahath Moab, of the children of Iofue: Iohab, two thouſand eight hundred fiftie foure. <sup>7</sup> The children of Aelam, a thouſand two hundred fiftie foure. <sup>8</sup> The children of Zethua, nine hundred fourtie five. <sup>9</sup> The children of Zachai, ſeuen hundred fixtie. <sup>10</sup> The children of Bani, fix hundred fourtie two. <sup>11</sup> The children of Bebai, fix hundred twentie three. <sup>12</sup> The children of Azgad, a thouſand two hundred twentie two. <sup>13</sup> The children of Adonicam, fix hundred fixtie fix. <sup>14</sup> The children of Beguai, two thouſand fiftie fix. <sup>15</sup> The children of Adin, foure hundred fiftie foure. <sup>16</sup> The children of Ather, which were of Ezechias, ninetie eight. <sup>17</sup> The children of Befai, three hundred and twentie three. <sup>18</sup> The children of Iora, an hundred twelue. <sup>19</sup> The children of Hafum, two hundred twentie three. <sup>20</sup> The children of Gebbar, ninetie five. <sup>21</sup> The children of Bethlehem, an hundred twentie three. <sup>22</sup> The men of Netupha, fiftie fix. <sup>23</sup> The men of Anathoth, an hundred twentie eight.

of Salomon, the children of Sotai, the children of Sophereth, the children of Pharuda, <sup>56</sup> the children of Iala, the children of Dercon, the childrẽ of Geddel, <sup>57</sup> the children of Saphatia, the children of Hatil, the children of Phochereth, which were of Afebaim, the children of Ami. <sup>58</sup> Al the Nathineites, and the children of the feruantes of Salomon, three hundred ninetie two. <sup>59</sup> And these are they that came vp from Thelmela, Thelharfa, Cherub, and Adon, and Emer. And they could not fthew the houe of their fathers and their feede, whether they were of Ifrael. <sup>60</sup> The children of Dalaia, the children of Tobia, the children of Necoda, fix hundred fiftie two. <sup>61</sup> And of the children of the Prieftes: The children of Hobia, the children of Accos, the children of Berzellai, who tooke a wife of the daughters of Berzellai the Galaadite, and was called by their name: <sup>62</sup> these fought the writing of their genealogie, and <sup>a</sup>)found it not, and they were caft out of the Priefthood. <sup>63</sup> And Atherfatha laid to them, that they fhould not eate of the Holie of holies, til there rofe a prieft learned and perfect. <sup>64</sup> Al the multitude as it were one man, <sup>b</sup>)fourtie two thoufand three hundred fixtie: <sup>65</sup> befide their men feruantes, & wemen feruantes, which were feuen thoufand three hundred thirtie feuen: and among them finging men, and finging wemen two hundred. <sup>66</sup> Their horfes feuen hundred thirtie fix, their mules two hundred fourtie fue, <sup>67</sup> their cameles, foure hundred thirtie fue, their affes fix thoufand feuen hundred twentie. <sup>68</sup> And of the princes of the fathers, when they entred into the temple of our Lord, which is in Ierufalem, they offered voluntarily vnto the houe of our Lord to build it in his place. <sup>69</sup> According to their abilities, they gaue the expenfes of the worke, of gold fixtie one thoufand foldes, of filuer fue thoufand poundes, &
