Chapter 10

Efdras calling the people together commandeth them to difmifse the ftrange wemen, which they have married: 14. appointing officers to fee it executed: 18. and reciteth those which had married fuch wemen.

fdras therfore thus praying, and befeeching, and weeping, and lying before the temple of God, there was gathered to him of Ifrael an exceeding great companie of men and wemen and children, and the people wept with much lamentation. ² And Sechenias the fonne of Iehiel of the children of Aelam anfwered, and faid to Efdras: We have tranfgreffed againft our God, and haue taken to wives ftrange wemen of the people of the land: and now if there be penance in Ifrael vpon this, ³ let vs make a couenant with the Lord our God, to put away all the wives, and them that are borne of them, according to the wil of our Lord, and of them that feare the precept of the Lord our God: be it done according to the law. ⁴ Arife, it is thy part to difcerne, and we wil be with thee: take courage, and doe it. ⁵ Efdras therefore rofe vp, and adjured the Princes of the Prieftes and of the Leuites, and al Ifrael, that they floud doe according to this word, and they fware. ⁶ And Efdras role vp before the houfe of God, and went to the chamber of ^{a)}Iohanan the fonne of Eliafib, and entered into it: he did eate no bread, and dranke no water: for he mourned for the transgreffion of them, that were come out of the captinitie. ⁷ And there was a proclamation fent in Iuda and Ierufalem, to all the children of the tranfmigration, that they fould affemble together into Ierufalem. ⁸ And euerie one that fhal not come within three dayes, according to the counfel of the princes and ancientes, al his fubftance fhal be taken away, and him

felfe fhal be caft out of the companie of the transfirmingration. ⁹ There affembled therfore al the men of Iuda, and Beniamin into Ierufalem withing three dayes, that is the ninth moneth, the twenteth day of the moneth: and al the people fate in the ftreate of the houfe of God, trembling for the finne, and ^{a)}the rayne. ¹⁰ And Efdras the Prieft arofe, and fayd to them: You have tranfgreffed, and taken ftrange wemen to wife, to adde upon the finne of Ifrael. ¹¹ And now geue confeffion to our Lord the God of your fathers, and doe his pleafure, and be feparated from the people of the land, and from your wives the ftrangers. ¹² And al the multitude anfwered, and favd with a lowde voyce: According to thy word vnto vs, fo be it done. ¹³ Neuertheleffe becaufe there is much people, and a tyme of rayne, and we can not abyde to ftand without, and it is not a worke of one day or two (for we have exceedingly finned in this thing) ¹⁴ let there be princes appoynted in al the multitude: and let al in our cities that have taken ftrangers to wife, come at fette tymes, and with them the ancientes by citie and citie, and the iudges theref, vntil the wrath of our God be turned away from vs for this finne. ¹⁵ Therfore Ionathan the fonne of Azahel, and Iaazia the fonne of Thecua were appoynted ouer this, and Mefollam and Sebethai Leuites did helpe them: ¹⁶ and the children of the transmigration did fo. And Efdras the Prieft, and the men, princes of the families went into the houfes of theyr fathers, and al by theyr names, and they fate in the first day of the tenth moneth to fearch out the matter. ¹⁷ And al the men were fully counted that had taken ftrangers to wife, vnto the first day of the first moneth. ¹⁸ And there were found of the fonnes of the Prieftes that had taken ftrangers to wife. Of the children of Iofue the fonne of Iofedec, and his brethren, Maafia, and Eliezer, and Iarib, and Godolia. ¹⁹ And they gaue theyr handes to put away theyr wives, and to offer for theyr offence a ramme of the flocke. ²⁰ And of the children of Emmer, Hanani, and

Zebedia. ²¹ And of the children of Harim, Maafia, and Elia, and Semeia, and Iehiel, and Ozias. ²² And of the children of Phefhur, Elionai, Maafia, Ifmael, Nathanael, Iozabed, and Elafa. ²³ And of the children of the Leuites, Iozabed, and Semei, and Celaia, the fame is Calita, Phataia, Iuda, and Eliezer. ²⁴ And of the finging men Eliafib: and of the porters, Sellum, and Thelem, and Vri. ²⁵ And of Ifrael, of the children of Pharos, Remeia, and Iezia, and Melchia, and Miamin, and Eliezer, and Melchia, and Banea. ²⁶ And of the children of Aelam, Mathania, Zacharias, and Iehiel, and Abdi, and Ierimoth, and Elia. ²⁷ And of the children of Zethua, Elioenai, Eliafib, Mathania, Ierimuth, and Zabad, and Aziza. ²⁸ And of the children of Bebai, Iohanan, Hanamia, Zabbai, Athalai.²⁹ And of the children of Bani, Mofollam, and Melluch, and Adaia, Iafub, and Saal, and Ramoth. ³⁰ And of the children of Phahath Moab, Edna, and Chalal, Bananias, and Maafias, Mathanias, Befeleel, Bennui, and Manaffe. ³¹ And of the children of Herem, Eliezer, Iofue, Melchias, Semeias, Simeon, ³² Beniamin, Maloch, Samarias. ³³ And of the children of Hafom, Mathanai, Mathatha, Zabad, Eliphelet, Iermai, Manaffe, Semei. ³⁴ Of the children of Bani, Maaddi, Amram, and Vel, ³⁵ Baneas, and Badaias, Cheliau, ³⁶ Vania, Marimuth, and Eliafib, ³⁷ Mathanias, Mathanai, and Iafi, ³⁸ and Bani, and Bennui, Semei, ³⁹ and Salmias, and Nathan, and Adaias, ⁴⁰ and Mechnedebai, Sifai, Sarai, ⁴¹ Ezrel, and Selemiau, Semeria, ⁴² Sellum, Amaria, Iofeph. ⁴³ Of the children of Nebo, Iehiel, Mathathias, Zabad, Zabina, Ieddu, and Ioel, and Banaia. ⁴⁴ Al thefe had taken ftrangers to wife, and there were of them that had borne ^{a)}children.
