Chapter 9

Saul by occafion of feeking his fathers also cometh to Samuel. 15. Who had a reuelation of his coming, and a commandment to annoint him. 22. He is entertained and lodged with Samuel.

The fecond part. The election, annointing, & gouernement of King Saul.

nd there was a man of Beniamin named Cis. the fonne of Abiel, the fonne of Seor, the - fonne of Bechorath, the fonne of Aphia, the fonne of a man of Iemini, valiant in ftrength.² And he had a fonne called Saul, chofen & good: and there was not a man of the children of Ifrael better then he: from the fhoulder and vpward he appeared aboue al the people. ³ And the affes of Cis the father of Saul were loft: and Cis faid to Saul his fonne: Take one of the feruants with thee, and rifing goe, and feeke the affes. Who when they had paffed by mount Ephraim, ⁴ and by the land of Salifa, and had not found, they paffed alfo through the land of Salim, and they were not: yea and by the Land of Iemini, and found them not. ⁵ And when they were come into the Land of Suph, Saul faide to the feruant that was with him: Come let vs returne, left perhaps my father hath let alone the affes, and be careful for vs. ⁶ Who favd to him: Behold a man of God is in this citie, a famous man: al that he fpeaketh, cometh to paffe without doubt. Now therfore let vs goe thither, if perhaps he may tel vs of our way, for which we are come. ⁷ And Saul fayd to his feruant: Loe we wil goe: what fhal we carie to the man of God? The bread is fpent in our males: and prefent we have none to geue vnto the man of God, nor anything els. ⁸ Agayne the feruant anfwered Saul, and fayd: Behold there is found in my hand the fourth part of a ficle of filuer, let vs geue it to the man of God, that he may tel vs our way. ⁹ (For in time paft in Ifrael fo euery man fpake, going to confult God: Come, and let vs goe to the Seer. For he that at this day is called a Prophete, in time paft was called ^a)a Seer.) ¹⁰ And Saul

fayd to his feruant: Thy word is very good, come let vs goe. And they went into the citie, wherein the man of God was. ¹¹ And when they went vp the afcent of the citie, they found maides coming forth to draw water, and fayd to them: Is the Seer here? ¹² Who anfwering fayd to them: Here he is. Loe before thee, make haft now: for this day he came into the citie, becaufe this day there is a facrifice of the people in the excelle. ¹³ Entring into the citie immediatly you fhal find him, before he goe vp into the excelle to eate. For the people wil not eate til he come: becaufe he wil bleffe the Hofte, and afterward they fhal eate that are inuited. Now therfore goe vp, becaufe this day you fhal finde him. ¹⁴ And they went vp into the citie. And when they walked in the middes of the citie, Samuel appeared coming forth againft them, to goe vp into the excelfe. ¹⁵ And our Lord had reueled the eare of Samuel one day before Saul came, faying: ¹⁶ This very houre, that now is, to morrow wil I fend to thee a man of the Land of Beniamin, and thou fhalt annoint him ruler ouer my people of Ifrael: and he shal faue my people from the hand of the Philiftijms: becaufe I have refpected my people, for a)their crie is come to me. ¹⁷ And when Samuel had beheld Saul, our Lord fayde to him: Behold the man, of whom I told thee, this man shal rule ouer my people. ¹⁸ And Saul came to Samuel in the middes of the gate, and fayd: Shew me, I pray thee, where is the houfe of the Seer? ¹⁹ And Samuel anfwered Saul, faying: I am the Seer, goe vp before me into the excelfe, that you may eate with me to day, and I will dimiffe thee in the morning: and all thinges that are in thy hart, wil I tel thee. ²⁰ And concerning the affes, which thou didft lofe three days agone, be not careful, becaufe they are found. And whofe shal be al the beft thinges of Ifrael? not to thee and to al thy fathers houfe? ²¹ And Saul anfwering, fayd: Am not I the fonne of Iemini of the leaft tribe of Ifrael, and my kindred the laft among al the families of the tribe of Beniamin? Why therfore haft thou fpoken this word to me?

²² Samuel therfore taking Saul and his feruant, brought them into the parlour, and gaue them a place in the chiefe rowme of them that were inuited, for there were about thirtie men. ²³ And Samuel fayd to the cooke: Geue the portion, which I gaue thee, and commanded that thou should ft lay it vp apart with thee. ²⁴ And the cooke lifted vp a shoulder, and fette it before Saul. And Samuel faid: Behold that which hath remayned. fette it before thee, and eate: becaufe of purpofe it was kept for thee, when I called the people. And Saul did eate with Samuel that day. ²⁵ And they defcended from the excelfe into the towne, and he fpake with Saul in the toppe of the houfe: and he prepared a bed for Saul in the higheft rowme, & he flept. ²⁶ And when they were rifen in the morning, and it beganne now to be light, Samuel called Saul in the high chaber, faying: Arife that I may difmiffe thee. And Saul arofe: and they went both forth: to witte, he and Samuel. ²⁷ And when they came downe in the vttermoft part of the citie, Samuel faid to Saul: Speake to the feruant that he goe before vs, and paffe: but ftay thou a litle while, that I may tel thee the word of our Lord.
