## Chapter 3

The fonnes of King Dauid. 10. The line of the Kinges of Iuda from Salomon to Iofias. 15. With divers generations of the fame Iofias.

ut Dauid had thefe fonnes, which were borne to him in Hebron: the firstbegotten Ammon of Achinoam the Iefraelite, the fecond Daniel of Abigail the Carmelite, <sup>2</sup> the third Abfolom the fonne of Maacha the daughter of Tolmai the king of Geffur, the fourth Adonias the fonne of Aggith, 3 the fift Saphatias of Abital, the fixth Iethraham of Egla his wife. 4 Six fonnes therfore were borne to him in Hebron, where he reigned feuen yeares and fix monethes. And in Ierufalem he reigned three and thirtie yeares. <sup>5</sup> Moreouer in Ierufalem fonnes were borne to him, Simmaa, and Sobab, and Nathan, & Salomon, foure of Bethfabea the daughter of Ammiel, <sup>6</sup> Iebaar also and Elifama, <sup>7</sup> and Eliphaleth, and Noge, and Nepheg, and Iaphia, 8 moreouer Elifanna, and Eliada, and Elipheleth, nine: <sup>9</sup> al thefe the fonnes of Dauid, befide the fonnes of his concubines: and they had a fifter Thamar. <sup>10</sup> And the fonne of Salomon, Roboam: whose fonne Abia begat Afa. Of this also was borne Iofaphat, 11 the father of Ioram: which Ioram begat Ochozias, of whom rofe Ioas: 12 and his fonne Amafias begat Azarias. Moreouer Azarias the fonne of Ioathan <sup>13</sup> begat Achaz, the father of Ezechias, of whom was borne Manaffes. <sup>14</sup> But Manaffes also begat Amon the father of Iofias. <sup>15</sup> And the fonnes of Iofias were: the firstbegotten Iohanam, the fecond a)Ioakim, the third Sedecias, the fourth Sellum. <sup>16</sup> Of Ioakim was borne Iechonias, and Sedecias. 17 The fonnes of Iechonias were Afir, Salathiel, <sup>18</sup> Melchiram, Phadaia, Sennefer & Iecemia, Sama, and Nadabia. <sup>19</sup> Of Phadaia were borne Zorobabel and Semei. Zorobabel begat Mofollom, Hananias,

and Salomith their fifter: <sup>20</sup> Hafaba alfo, and Ohol, and Barachias, and Hafadias, Iafabhefed, fiue. <sup>21</sup> And the fonne of Hananias, Phaltias the father of Iefeias, whofe fonne was Raphaia. This mans fonne alfo Arnan, of whom was borne Obdia, whofe fonne was Sechenias. <sup>22</sup> The fonne of Sechenias: Semeia, whofe fonnes were Hattus, and Iegaal, and Baria, and Naaria, and Saphat, <sup>a)</sup>fix in number. <sup>23</sup> The fonnes of Naaria: Elioenai, & Ezechias, and Ezricam, three. <sup>24</sup> The fonnes of Elioenai: Oduia, and Eliafub, and Pheleia, and Accub, and Iohanan, and Dalaia, and Anani, feuen.
