

## Chapter 4

*Other genealogies of Iuda: 24. and of Simeon, 29. by whom the progenie of Cham, 42. and reliques of Amelacites are fubdued.*

**T**he fonnes of Iuda: Phares, Hefron, and Charmi, and Hur, and Sobal. <sup>2</sup> But Raia the fonne of Sobal begat Iahath, of whom were borne Ahumai, and Laad. Thefe be the kinredes of Sarathi. <sup>3</sup> This alfo is the ftocke of Etam: Iezrahel, and Iefema, and Iedebos. And the name of their fifter Afalelphuni. <sup>4</sup> And Phanuel the father of Gedor, and Ezar the father of Hofa, thefe are the fonnes of Hur the firft begotten of Ephratha the father of Bethlehem. <sup>5</sup> But Affur the father of Thecua had two wiues, Halaa, & Naara. <sup>6</sup> And Naara bare him Oozam, and Hephher, and Themani, and Ahafthari. Thefe are the fonnes of Naara. <sup>7</sup> Moreouer the fonnes of Halaa: Sereth, Ifaar, and Ethnan. <sup>8</sup> And Cos begat Anob, and Soboba, and the kinred of Aharehel the fonne of Arum. <sup>9</sup> And Iabes was honorable aboute his brethren, and his mother called his name Iabes, faying: Becaufe I bare him in forow. <sup>10</sup> But <sup>a</sup>Iabes inuocated the God of Ifrael, faying: If bleffing thou wilt bleffe me, and wilt enlarge my borders, and thy hand be with me, and thou wilt make that I be not oppreffed by malice. And God granted the thinges that he prayed for. <sup>11</sup> And Caleb the brother of Sua begat Mahir, who was the father of Efthon. <sup>12</sup> Moreouer Efthon begat Bethrapha, and Pheffe, and Tehinna the father of the citie of Naas: thefe are the men of Recha. <sup>13</sup> And the fonnes of Cenez: Othoniel, and Saraia. Moreouer the fonnes of Othoniel: Hathath, and Maonathi.

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<sup>a</sup> In ioyning a vow to his prayer he imitated holie Iacob. *Gen. 28.* And they both defired temporal thinges for the better feruing of God, & aduancing his glorie: efpecially that they might be affited with grace not to yeld to tentations, nor finne of malice.

<sup>14</sup> Maonathi begat Ophra, & Saraia begat Ioab <sup>a)</sup>the father of the Vale of Artificers: for there were artificers.  
<sup>15</sup> And the fonnes of Caleb the fonne of Iephone: Hir, and Ela, and Naham. The fonnes alfo of Ela: Cenez. <sup>16</sup> The fonnes alfo of Ialeleel: Ziph, and Zipha, Thiria, and Afrael. <sup>17</sup> And the fonnes of Efra: Iether, and Mered, and Epher, and Ialon, and he begat Mariam, and Sammai, and Iefba the father of Efthamo. <sup>18</sup> Alfo his wife Iudaia, bare Iared the father of Gedor, and Heber the father of Socho, and Ieuthiel the father of Zanoë. And thefe are the fonnes of Bethia the daughter of Pharao, whom Mered tooke. <sup>19</sup> And the fonnes of the wife of Odaia the fifter of Naham the father of Ceila, Garmi, and Efthamo, which was of Macathi. <sup>20</sup> The fonnes alfo Simon, Amnon, and Rinna the fonne of Hanan, and Thilon. And the fonnes of Iefi: Zoheth, and Benzoheth. <sup>21</sup> The fonnes of Sela the fonne of Iuda: Her the father of Lecha, and Laada the father of Marefa, and the kinredes of their houfe that worke filke in the Houfe of oath. <sup>22</sup> And he that made the Sunne to ftand, and the men of Lying, and Secure, and Burning, which were princes in Moab, and which returned into Lahem. And thefe are old wordes. <sup>23</sup> Thefe are potters, dwelling in Plantinges, and in Hedges, with the king in his workes, and they abode there. <sup>24</sup> The fonnes of Simeon: Namuel, and Iamin, Iarib, Zara, Saul: <sup>25</sup> Sellum his fonne, Mapfam his fonne, Mafma his fonne. <sup>26</sup> The fonnes of Mafma: Hamuel his fonne, Zachur his fonne, Semei his fonne. <sup>27</sup> The fonnes of Semei fixtene, and fix daughters: but his brethren had not manie fonnes, and the whole kinred could not reach to the fumme of the children of Iuda. <sup>28</sup> And they dwelt in Berfabee, and Molada, and Hafarfuhal, <sup>29</sup> and in Bala, and in Afom, and in Tholad, <sup>30</sup> and in Bathuel, and in Hormi, and in Siceleg, <sup>31</sup> and in Bethmarcaboth, and in Hafarfufim, and in Bethberai, and in Saatim. Thefe were their cities vntil king Dauid. <sup>32</sup> Their townes alfo: Etam, and Aen, Rhemmon, and

Thochen, and Afan, five cities. <sup>33</sup> And al their villages round about these cities vnto Baal. This is their habitation, and the distribution of their dwellings. <sup>34</sup> Mofabab also and Iemlech, and Iofa the sonne of Amafias, <sup>35</sup> and Ioel, and Iehu the sonne of Iofabia the sonne of Saraia, the sonne of Afiel, <sup>36</sup> and Elioenai, and Iacoba, and Ifuhaia, and Afaia, and Adiel, and Ifmiel, and Banaia, <sup>37</sup> Ziza also the sonne of Zephei the sonne of Allon the sonne of Idaia the sonne of Semri the sonne of Samaia. <sup>38</sup> These renowned princes in their kinredes, & in the house of their affinities they were multiplied exceedingly. <sup>39</sup> And they went forth to enter into Gador as far as the East side of the valley, and to seeke pastures for their flocks. <sup>40</sup> And they found fatte pastures, and very good, and a countrie very large and quiet and fruiteful, in the which before had dwelt the stocke of Cham. <sup>41</sup> These therefore, whom before we described by name, came in the dayes of Ezechias the king of Iuda: and they stroke their tabernacles, and the inhabitantes that were found there, & cleane destroyed them vntil this present day: and they dwelt for them, because they found there most fatte pastures. <sup>42</sup> Also of the children of Simeon there went into mount Seir five hundred men, hauing their princes Phaltias and Naaria and Raphaia and Oziel the sonnes of Iefi: <sup>43</sup> and they stroke the remnant of the Amalecites, which were able to escape, and they dwelt there for them vntil this day.
