Chapter 9

VVho of Ifrael (after the captiuitie) first inhabited Ierusalem. 10. VVho exercised the offices of Priestes, 14. and Leuites, 35. with repetition of part of Sauls progenie.

l Ifrael therfore a)was numbred: and the fumme of them was written in the Booke of the kinges of Ifrael, and Iuda: and they were transported into Babylon for their finne. ² And they that dwelt first in their poffessions and in their cities: Ifrael, and the Prieftes, and the Leuites, and the Nathineans. ³ There dwelt in Ierufalem of the children of Iuda, and of the children of Beniamin, also of the children of Ephraim, and Manaffes. 4 Othei the fonne of Ammiud, the fonne of Amri, the fonne of Omrai, the fonne of Bonni, of the fonnes of Phares the fonne of Iuda. ⁵ And of Siloni: Afaia the firstbegotten, and his sonnes. 6 And of the fonnes of Zara: Iehuel, and their brethren, fix hundred ninetie. ⁷ Moreouer of the fonnes of Beniamin: Salo the fonne of Mofollam, the fonne of Odiua the fonne of Afana: 8 and Iobania the fonne of Ieroham: and Ela the fonne of Ozi, the fonne of Mochori: and Mofollam the fonne of Saphatias, the fonne of Rahuel, the fonne of Iebania, ⁹ and their brethren by their families, nine hundred fiftie fix. Al these princes of their kinredes by the houses of their fathers. ¹⁰ And of the priestes: Iedaia, Ioiarib, and Iachin: 11 Azarias also the sonne of Helcias, the fonne of Mofollam, the fonne of Sadoc, the fonne of Maraioth, the fonne of Achitob, high prieft of the house of God. 12 Moreouer Adaias the sonne of Ieroham, the fonne of Phaffur, the fonne of Melchias: and Maafai the fonne of Adiel, the fonne of Iezra, the fonne of Mofollam, the fonne of Mofollamith, the fonne of Emmer. 13 Their brethren also princes by their families a thousand seuen hundred three score, most able men of

ftrength to the worke of the ministerie in the house of God. ¹⁴ And of the Leuites: Semeia the fonne of Haffub, the fonne of Ezricam, the fonne of Hafebia of the fonnes of Merari. ¹⁵ Bacbacar also a carpenter, and Galal, and Mathania the fonne of Micha, the fonne of Zechri, the fonne of Afaph: ¹⁶ and Obdia the fonne of Semeia, the fonne of Galal, the fonne of Idithun: and Barachia the fonne of Afa, the fonne of Elcana, who dwelt in the courtes of Netophati. 17 And the porters: Sellum, and Accub, and Telmon, and Ahimam: and their brother Sellum the prince, ¹⁸ vntil that time, in the kinges gate toward the eaft, wayted by their courses of the children of Leui. 19 But Sellum the fonne of Core the fonne of Abiafaph, the fonne of Core, with his brethren, and his fathers house, these are the Corites ouer the workes of the ministerie, keepers of the entrances of the tabernacle: and their families in courfe keeping the entrance of the campe of our Lord. 20 And Phinees the fonne of Eleafar, was their prince before our Lord. ²¹ Moreouer Zacharias the fonne of Mofollamia, porter of the gate of the tabernacle of testimonie. ²² Al these chosen men for porters, at euerie gate, two hundred twelue: and appointed out in their proper townes. Whom Dauid and Samuel the Seer appointed, vpon their fidelitie. 23 As wel them as their fonnes, in the doores of the house of our Lord, and in the tabernacle by their courses. 24 By the source windes were the porters: that is to fay, toward the Eaft, and toward the West, and toward the North, and toward the South. ²⁵ And their brethren dwelt in villages, and came vpon their Sabbathes from time to time. ²⁶ To thefe four Leuites was committed all the number of porters, and they were ouer the chambers, and treasures of the house of our Lord. 27 Also round about the temple of our Lord they abode in their watches: that when it was time, they in the morning might open the doores. 28 Of thefe mens ftocke there were also ouer the veffels of the ministerie: for by number the vessels were both brought in and caried out. ²⁹ Of them also they that had the implements of the fanctuarie committed vnto them, did ouerfee the floure, and wine, and oile, and frankincenfe,

and fpices. ³⁰ And the fonnes of prieftes made oyntementes of the fpices. 31 And Mathathias a Leuite the first begotten of Sellum the Corite, was ouerseer of those thinges, which were fryed in the frying panne. ³² Moreouer of the children of Caath their brethren, there were ouer the loaues of proposition, to prepare alwaies new euerie Sabbath. ³³ Thefe are the chief of the finging men by the families of the Leuites, which abode in the chambers, that they might day and night continually ferue in their ministerie. ³⁴ The heades of the Leuites, princes in their families, taried in Ierufalem. 35 And in Gabaon abode Iehiel the father of Gabaon, and the name of his wife Maacha. ³⁶ His first begotten sonne Abdon, and Sur, and Cis, and Baal, and Ner, and Nadab, ³⁷ Gedor alfo, and Ahio, and Zacharias, and Macelloth. 38 Moreouer Macelloth begat Samaan: thefe dwelt ouer agaynft their brethren in Ierufalem, with their brethren. ³⁹ And Ner begat Cis: and Cis begat Saul: and Saul begat Ionathas, and Melchifua, and Abinadab, and Efbaal. 40 And the fonne of Ionathas, Meribbaal: and Meribbaal begat Micha. 41 Moreouer the fonnes of Micha: Phithon, and Melech, and Tharaa, and Ahaz. 42 And Ahaz begat Iara, and Iara begat Alamath, and Azmoth, and Zamri. And Zamri begat Mofa. 43 And Mofa begat Banaa: whofe fonne Raphaia begat Elafa: of whom was borne Afel. 44 Moreouer Afel had fix fonnes of thefe names: Ezricam, Bochru, Ifmael, Saria, Obdia, Hanan, thefe are the fonnes of Afel.
