Porters are defigned by lottes to watch at foure gates of the temple. 20. Others made kepers of the holie treafure, and veffel. 30. Officers alfo appointed in the two tribes and half ouer Iordan, for Gods feruice, and the kinges.

nd the diuifions of the porters: of the Corites Mefelemia, the fonnes of Core, of the fonnes of Afaph. ² The fonnes of Mefelemia: Zacharias the first begotten, Iadihel the fecond, Zabadias the third, Iathanael the fourth, ³ Aelam the fifth, Iohanan the fixth, Elioenai the feuenth. ⁴ And the fonnes of Obededom: Semeias the firstbegotten, Iozabad the fecond, Ioaha the third, Sachar the fourth, Nathanael the fifth, ⁵ Ammiel the fixth, Iffachar the feuenth, Phollathi the eight: becaufe our Lord bleffed him. ⁶ And to Semias his fonne were borne fonnes, the chiefe of their families: for they were most valiant men. ⁷ The fonnes then of Semeias: Othni, and Raphael, and Obed, Elizabad, and his brethren moft valiant men: Eliu alfo, and Samachias. ⁸ Al thefe of the fonnes of Obededom: they, and their fonnes, and their brethren moft able to minifter, fixtie two of Obededom. ⁹ Moreouer the fonnes of Mefelemia, and their brethren moft ftrong, eightene. ¹⁰ And of Hofa, that is of the fonnes of Merari: Semri the prince (a) for he had not a firftbegotten, and therfore his father made him chief) ¹¹ Helcias the fecond, Tabelias the third, Zacharias the fourth: al thefe the fonnes, and brethren to Hofa, thirtene. ¹² Thefe were diuided into porters, that the princes also of the watches, euen as their brethren, might minifter in the houfe of our Lord. ¹³ Lottes therfore were caft equally, both to litle, and great, by their families for euerie one of the gates. ¹⁴ The lotte then of the Eaft fel to Selemia. Moreouer to Zacharias his fonne, a moft wife man, and skilful, the North guarter chanced by lot. ¹⁵ But to Obededom and his fonnes, toward the South:

in which part of the houfe was the councel of the ancientes. ¹⁶ Sephim, and Hofa toward the Weft, by the gate, which leadeth to the way of afcent: watch againft watch. ¹⁷ And toward the Eaft fix Leuites: and toward the North foure a day: and toward the South likewife in a day foure: and where the councel was two and two. ¹⁸ In the celles alfo of the porters toward the Weft foure in the way: and two at euerie celle. ¹⁹ Thefe be the diuifions of the porters of the fonnes of Core, and of Merari. ²⁰ Moreouer Achias was ouer the treafures of the houfe of God, and the veffels of the holie places. ²¹ The fonnes alfo of Ledan, the fonnes of Gerfonni: of Ledan princes of the families, Ledan, and Gerfonni, Iehieli. ²² The fonnes of Iehieli: Zathan, and Ioel his brethren ouer the treafures of the houfe of our Lord, ²³ to the Amramites, and Ifaarites, and Hebronites, and Ozielites. ²⁴ And Subael the fonne of Gerfom, the fonne of Moyfes, chiefe ouer the treafures. ²⁵ His brethren alfo Eliezer, whofe fonne Rahabia, and his fonne Ifaias, and his fonne Ioram, his fonne alfo Zechri, and his fonne Selemith. ²⁶ Selemith himfelf, and his brethren ouer the treafures of the fanctified holie thinges, which Dauid the king a)fanctified, and the princes of families, and the centurions, and the captaynes of the hoft 27 of the warres, and of the fpoyles of the battels, which they had confecrated to the maynteynance and furniture of the temple of our Lord. ²⁸ And al thefe thinges did Samuel the Seer fanctifie, and Saul the fonne of Cis, and Abner the fonne of Ner, and Ioab the fonne of Saruia: and al that had fanctified them by the hand of Selemith, and of his brethren. ²⁹ But the chiefe ouer the Ifaarites was Chonenias, and his fonnes to the workes abrode ouer Ifrael to teach and judge them. ³⁰ Moreouer the Hebronites Hafabias, and his brethren, most able men, a thoufand feuen hundred were chiefe ouer Ifrael beyond Iordan agaynft the Weft, in al the workes of our Lord, and for the minifterie of the king. ³¹ And the prince of the Hebronites was Ieria according to their families

and kinredes. In the fourteth years of king Dauid they were numbred, and there were found moft valiant men in Iazer Galaad, ³² and his brethren of ftronger age, two thoufand feuen hundred princes of families. And Dauid the king made them ouerfeers ouer the Rubenites and the Gaddites, and the halfe tribe of Manaffes, for al the minifterie of God, and the king.
