Chapter 13

Abias maketh warre agaynft Ieroboam, 4. exhorteth the people of Ifrael for iuftice, and religions fake to returne to him. 13. In the meane time Ieroboam inuironeth him with forces, but by Gods afsiftance Abias preuaileth, 21. and reigneth fecurely.

n the eightenth yeare of king Ieroboam, reigned Abias ouer Iuda. ² Three yeares reigned he in Ierufalem, and his mothers name was Michaia, the daughter of Vriel of Gabaa: there was warre betwen Abias and Ieroboam. ³ And when Abias had begun battel, and had most warlike men, & of chosen ones four hundreth thousand: Ieroboam put his armie in aray on the contrarie fide, eight hundreth thousand men, who them felues also were chosen men, and most valiant to battels. 4 Abias therfore ftood vpon mount Semeron, which was in Ephraim, and favd: Heare Ieroboam, and al Ifrael: ⁵ Are you ignorant that our Lord the God of Ifrael gaue the kingdom to Dauid ouer Ifrael for euer, to him and his children as a a)couenant of falt? 6 And there rofe vp Ieroboam the fonne of Nabat, the feruant of Salomon the fonne of Dauid: and rebelled agaynft his lord. ⁷ And there were gathered to him al the most vayne men, and the children of Belial: and they preuayled agaynft Roboam the fonne of Salomon: moreouer Roboam was rude, and of a fearful hart, and could not refift them. 8 Now therfore you fay that you are able to refift the kingdom of our Lord, which he poffeffeth by the children of Dauid, and you have a great multitude of people, and golden calues, which Ieroboam hath made you for goddes. 9 And you have caft out the Prieftes of our Lord, the children of Aaron, and the Leuites: and you have made you prieftes, as all the peoples of the earth: who foeuer fhal come & confecrate his hand in a bullock of oxen, and in feuen rammes, is made the prieft of them

that are not goddes. ¹⁰ But our Lord is God, whom we forfake not, and the Prieftes do minister to our Lord of the children of Aaron, and the Leuites are in their order. ¹¹ Holocauftes also they do offer to our Lord, euerie day morning and euening, and incenfe made according to the preceptes of the law, and the loaues are fet forth on a most cleane table, and there is with vs the golden candlefticke, and the lampes therof, that they may be lighted alwaies at euening: for we keepe the preceptes of the Lord our God, whom you have forfaken. 12 Therfore in our hoft God is the prince, and his Prieftes, which found with trumpettes, and refound agaynft you: children of Ifrael fight not agaynft our Lord the God of your fathers, because it is not expedient for you. ¹³ He speaking thefe thinges, Ieroboam endeuoured to entrappe him behind. And when he ftood ouer agaynft the enemies, he compaffed Iuda vnwitting with his armie. ¹⁴ And Iudas looking backe, faw the battel at hand before and behind, and cryed to our Lord: and the Prieftes begane to found with trumpettes. ¹⁵ And al the men of Iuda made a flout: and behold they crying, God terrified Ieroboam, and al Ifrael that ftood agaynft Abias and Iuda. ¹⁶ And the children of Ifrael fled from Iuda, and our Lord deliuered them into their hand. 17 Abias therfore and his people ftroke them with a great flaughter, and there fel wounded of Ifrael fiue hundreth thousand valiant men. ¹⁸ And the children of Ifrael were humbled, at that time, and the children of Iuda excedingly encouraged because they had trusted in our Lord the God of their fathers. ¹⁹ And Abias purfewed Ieroboam fleing, and he tooke his cities, Bethel and her daughters, and Iefana with her daughters, Ephron also and her daughters. ²⁰ Neither was Ieroboam able to refift anie more in the daies of Abias: whom our Lord ftroke, and he died. 21 Therfore Abias, his empire being ftrengthened, tooke fourtene wives: and he begat two and twentie fonnes, and fixtene daughters. 22 But the reft of the wordes of Abias, and of his waies and wordes, are writen diligently in the Booke of Addo the Prophete.
