## Chapter 17

Iofaphat fucceding in the kingdom preuaileth in battel agaynft the king of Ifrael, 6. deftroyeth Idolaters, and fendeth Prieftes and Leuites to inftruct the people. 11. The Philiftians and Arabians fend prefentes to king Iofaphat. 13. The leaders of the armie and fouldiars are numbred.

nd Iofaphat his fonne reigned for him, & grew ftrong agaynft Ifrael. <sup>2</sup> And he appoynted numbers of fouldiars in al the cities of Iuda, that were compafied with walles. And he placed garrifons in the land of Iuda, and in the cities of Ephraim, which Afa his father had taken. <sup>3</sup> And our Lord was with Iofaphat, becaufe he walked in the first waies of Dauid his father: and he trufted not in Baalim, <sup>4</sup> but in the God of his father, and went forward in his preceptes, and not according to the finnes of Ifrael. <sup>5</sup> And our Lord confirmed the kingdom in his hand, and al Iuda gaue giftes to Iofaphat: and there grew to him infinite riches, and much glorie. <sup>6</sup> And when his hart had taken courage <sup>a)</sup> for the waies of our Lord, he tooke away alfo the Excelfes and groues out of Iuda. <sup>7</sup> And in the third years of his kingdom, he fent of his princes Benhail, and Abdias, and Zacharias, and Nathanael, and Micheas, that they floud teach in the cities of Iuda: <sup>8</sup> and with them Leuites, Semeias, and Nathanias, and Zabadias, Afael alfo, and Semiramoth, and Ionathan, and Adonias and Tobias, and Thobadonias Leuites, and with them Elifama, and Ioram Prieftes. <sup>9</sup> And they taught the people in Iuda, having the booke of the law of our Lord: and they went about al the cities of Iuda, and inftructed the people. <sup>10</sup> Therfore the dread of our Lord came upon all the kingdomes of the landes, that

were round about Iuda, neither durft they make battel agaynft Iofaphat. <sup>11</sup> Yea and the Philiftians brought giftes to Iofaphat, and tribute of filuer, the Arabians alfo brought cattel, of rammes feuen thousand feuen hundred, and buckegoates as manie. <sup>12</sup> Iofaphat therfore grewe, and was magnified on high: and he built in Iuda houfes like to toures, and walled cities. <sup>13</sup> And he prepared manie workes in the cities of Iuda: there were alfo men of warre, and valiant in Ierufalem, <sup>14</sup> of whom this is the number by the houfes and families of euerie one: In Iuda princes of the armie, Ednas duke, and with him moft valiant men three hundred thoufand. <sup>15</sup> After him Iohanan the prince, and with him two hundred eightie thoufand. <sup>16</sup> After him alfo Amafias the fonne of Zechri, confectated to our Lord, and with him two hundred thousand of valiant men. <sup>17</sup> Him followed Eliada valiant to battels, and with him of them that held bow & fhield two hundred thousand. <sup>18</sup> After this man alfo Iozabad, and with him an hundred eightie thousand readie fouldiars. <sup>19</sup> Al thefe were at the hand of the king, befide others, whom he had put in walled cities, in al Iuda.
